HISTORY OF THE REVEREND MONSIGNOR JOHN LAWRENCE MC LAUGHLIN KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS COUNCIL 9475

In the fall of 1986, Knights of Columbus Insurance Representative Jim Crow requested and Fr. Bert Connor, Pastor of Christ Our King Parish, granted permission for him to speak at our Sunday Masses about the Knights of Columbus.

Sufficient personnel became interested, not only persons who were not Knights but also other non-active members of the Knights were interested in forming a Council.

As a result of these recruitments after Mass, then Worthy District Deputy Steve Dunlap was introduced to the group. Due to Brothers Dunlap and Crow's dedication, persistence, and leadership, this Council became a viable living group of Catholic gentlemen interested in furthering the good order of the Knights of Columbus.

This Council's name was the result of the submission of many names at our organizational meetings. Brother Ruford Bolchoz suggested the name that was selected. This was very appropriate because this was the first Knights of Columbus Council in the East Cooper Area (Mt. Pleasant, Sullivans Island, and Isle of Palms) and Monsignor Mc Laughlin was the first Pastor of Christ Our King Church at a time when it was a mission church.

These organizational meetings resulted in the Chartering of the Council. Since charter night the Council has continued to grow. Under the leadership of Grand Knight Ruford Bolchoz our First Degree Team was formed in 1988 and certified.
