I am sure that you will continue to give your support and advice to the newly elected officers.

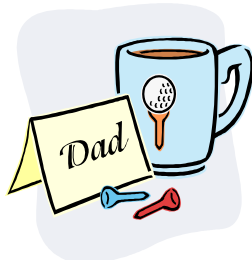
